Committee members discussed proposed changes to several federally/state-funded programs that will adversely affect senior adults in Dane County.

- Medicare: Dane and Milwaukee Counties held advocacy sessions ("Save Medicare"). Additional advocacy workshops are planned throughout the state by Greater Wisconsin Agency on Aging Resources (GWAAR).
- Affordable Care Act: Several Committee members expressed concern that selecting, changing/deleting certain aspects of the national plan could result in insurance companies dropping out, resulting in costs of those remaining in the plan to increase dramatically.
- Older Americans Act: Committee members are concerned funding for this program will be reduced, resulting in negatively impacting vital senior programs and services.
- Dementia Care Specialists: This program is not included in the Governor's proposed 2018-2019 state budget despite being recommended by the 2015 Assembly Speaker's Task Force on Alzheimer's and Dementia. Gundermann announced Task Force Chair and Representative Rohrkaste is meeting with the Governor to discuss the future of this program; however, Gundermann feels there is not enough support from the GOP and will not lobby for the program's inclusion in the 2018 state budget.

Frazier volunteered to work with AAA staff in drafting a letter to be signed by the AAA Board identifying concerns of the proposed Medicaid block grants by the federal government.
