The City of Edgerton wishes to provide the following comments regarding CUP #2373 scheduled for a hearing this evening.

The City's concerns regarding the proposed mineral extraction use focus on truck traffic and road damage. It is our understanding that at least one of the alternative locations from where aggregate will be mined for the I39/90 project if CUP #2373 were not approved is south of Edgerton on US Hwy 51. Material from the pit south of Edgerton would be transported through Edgerton to access the I39/90 corridor. We are very concerned about the estimated quantity of trucks as well as the damaged caused by the trucks to our local streets. Hwy 51 is the interstate alternate route causing concern for traffic volume on a daily basis as well as under circumstances when interstate traffic is diverted. From a transportation perspective, the City supports the idea of aggregate being mined along the interstate corridor to reduce noise, dirt, and street damage to our local streets.
