

MOTION ORDERING A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR
DANE COUNTY SUPERVISOR – DISTRICT 16

The Dane County Board of Supervisors hereby orders that a special election be held for the office of Dane County Supervisor – District 16, made vacant on March 27, 2017 by Supervisor Dave de Felice. The duly elected supervisor shall serve for the remainder of the term ending on April 16, 2018.

The special election will be held on Tuesday, June 13, 2017. If there are three or more candidates, a special primary will be held on Tuesday, May 16, 2017. Nomination papers for this office may be circulated beginning Friday, April 7, 2017 and the deadline for filing nomination papers is 5 p.m. on Tuesday, April 18. Candidates are required to gather a minimum of 50 and a maximum of 200 valid signatures.
