ACCEPTANCE OF A GYPSY MOTH SUPPRESSION GRANT
FROM THE WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

The Land & Water Resources Department has secured an \$8,499 Gypsy Moth Suppression Program Grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR).

Dane County serves as the coordinating agency which allows for municipalities to be eligible for cost sharing through the WDNR. The program works to suppress damaging gypsy moth populations with an aerial insecticide treatment should conditions warrant. This year, the City of Madison has requested treatment from the WDNR for 187.2 acres.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept the \$8,499 Gypsy Moth Suppression grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that revenue and expense accounts LWRPKOP 81616 & LWPRKOP 21130 be increased by \$8,499. All funds shall carry forward until realized and expended.
