2017 RES - 010 1 2 AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF LAND AND A CONSERVATION EASEMENT IN THE CHEROKEE MARSH NATURAL RESOURCE AREA 3 4 5 Dane County has negotiated the purchase of property in the Cherokee Marsh Natural Resource Area, along the Yahara River. The project includes the acquisition of 6 7 approximately 53 acres, with an additional approximate 77 acres protected through a 8 conservation easement. 9 10 Acquisition of these properties is a recommendation of the 2012-2017 Dane County 11 Parks & Open Space Plan. In addition to increasing public access to the Yahara River, 12 the acquisition will connect to public lands owned by the WI DNR that have little to no 13 access. The project also offers an opportunity to promote agricultural and rural 14 preservation, as consistent with Dane County Comprehensive Plan, the Village of 15 Waunkage and Town of Westport Comprehensive Plan, and the Village of Deforest 16 Comprehensive Plan. 17 18 The purchase price of property and easement is \$1,522,871 (Acreage adjustments 19 pending a final survey of lands south of STH 19 shall be made at \$13,000/acre.) Funds 20 for the project are available in the Lake Preservation & Renewal Fund. The debt issued 21 to support this expenditure will have a term of 20 years. 22 23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and 24 County Executive hereby authorize the purchase of land and a conservation easement 25 from Ronald and Heather Treinen and that the land rights be managed under the 26 jurisdiction of the Dane County Park Commission according to Wis. Stats. 27.05(3). 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Dane County Clerk and County Executive are 29 hereby authorized to execute the described easement and related documents on behalf 30 of Dane County; and 31 32 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Land & Water Resources Deputy Director or Real 33 Estate Coordinator are authorized to administer the closing and the transfer of the

property interests to Dane County and the Controller is authorized to issue checks

necessary to effectuate the transaction.
