1 2 AUTHORIZING GRANT APPLICATION TO THE WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL 3 RESOURCES FOR THE CAPITAL CITY STATE TRAIL PAVEMENT RESTORATION 4

5 The WI Department of Natural Resources administers grant programs that support development costs for projects identified in the Dane County Parks & Open Space Plan. 6 7 These programs include the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program and the 8 Recreational Trails Program. The Department of Land and Water Resources intends to 9 apply for these funds in order to off set expenditures for the Capital City State Trail 10 Pavement Restoration Project.

12 The Capital City State Trail was constructed in 2000. It is due for a major renovation 13 that entails complete replacement of the pavement for the entire length of the 9-mile trail 14 that is located south of Madison between Verona Rd and Nob Hill Road. .

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Board of Supervisors and 17 County Executive hereby authorize an application to the WI Department of Natural 18 Resources for financial assistance for the Capital City State Trail Restoration Project.

19 20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Board of Supervisors and County 21 Executive hereby authorize the Parks Planner and Acquisition & Planning Specialist to 22 submit a grant application to the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, 23 submit reimbursement claims along with necessary supporting documentation within 6 24 months of project completion, submit signed documents and take necessary action to 25 undertake, direct and complete approved projects.

26 27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the County Board of Supervisors and County Executive recognize and acknowledge the long-term ownership and management 28 29 responsibilities of the Stewardship and Recreational Trails Programs, and will comply 30 with all program laws and regulations and will meet their obligations under any grant 31 agreements for the projects, including the financial obligations under any grants.
