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AN INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS AND PROMISSORY NOTES

4 WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors (the "County Board") of Dane County, 5 Wisconsin (the "County") hereby finds and determines that it is necessary, desirable and in the 6 best interest of the County to issue, pursuant to Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds and promissory notes in an amount of not to exceed \$74,720,000 for public 7 purposes consisting of (a) paying the cost of various items included in the County's Capital 8 9 Budget including but not limited to: general government; public safety; human services; 10 conservation and economic development; culture and recreation; and public works projects, as listed with estimated amounts below and (b) paying professional fees and expenses in connection 11 with the issuance of the general obligation bonds and promissory notes (collectively, the 12 13 "Project"):

WHEREAS, the County Board finds and determines that the Project is within the
County's power to undertake and serves a "public purpose" as that term is defined in Section
67.04(1)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, counties are authorized by the provisions of Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes
 to borrow money and to issue general obligation bonds and promissory notes for such public
 purposes.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of the County that:

<u>Section 1. Authorization of 2017 Obligations</u>. For the purpose of financing the Project,
 there shall be borrowed pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the principal sum not
 to exceed \$74,720,000. The County expects to issue general obligation promissory notes to
 finance all projects described above with a term of 10 years or less and the County expects to
 issue general obligation bonds to finance the projects described above with a term of 20 years
 (collectively, the "2017 Obligations").

The County is authorized to proceed with the Project in advance of borrowing pursuant to Section 29.52(11) of the Dane County Ordinance.

31 Section 2. Sale of the 2017 Obligations. The County Board hereby authorizes and
 32 directs that the 2017 Obligations be offered for public sale. At a subsequent meeting, the County

Board shall consider such bids for the 2017 Obligations as may have been received and take

34 action thereon.

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Section 3. Official Notice of Sale. The Controller (in consultation with the County's
 financial advisor, Ehlers & Associates, Inc. ("Ehlers")) is hereby authorized and directed to cause
 the sale of the 2017 Obligations to be publicized at such times and in such manner as the
 Controller may determine and to cause copies of a complete Notice of Sale and other pertinent

- 39 data to be forwarded to interested bidders as the Controller (in consultation with Ehlers) may
- 40 determine.

41 <u>Section 4. Official Statement</u>. The Controller (in consultation with Ehlers) shall also 42 cause an Official Statement to be prepared and distributed. The appropriate County officials 43 shall determine when the Official Statement is final for purposes of Securities and Exchange 44 Commission Rule 15c2-12 and shall certify said Statement, such certification to constitute full 45 authorization of such Statement under this Resolution.

46 Section 5. Conflicting Resolutions; Severability; Effective Date. All prior resolutions, 47 rules or other actions of the County Board or any parts thereof in conflict with the provisions 48 hereof shall be, and the same are, hereby rescinded insofar as the same may so conflict. In the 49 event that any one or more provisions hereof shall for any reason be held to be illegal or invalid, 50 such illegality or invalidity shall not affect any other provisions hereof. The foregoing shall take

51 effect immediately upon adoption and approval in the manner provided by law.
