Background

- Dane County/Madison CoC one of more than 72 communities participating.
- Technical assistance provided.
- Goal to **reach functional zero** for:
 - Individuals who are Chronically Homeless.
 - Individuals who are homeless Veterans.

Background, Con't.

• Helped drive <u>key changes</u> in our system:

– Coordinated entry.

- Common assessment for housing (VI-SPDAT).
- By-name list.
- Housing placement group.

Goals and Update

- Set a goal to end homelessness for:
 - 130 veterans by 2015, and,
 - 135 individuals who are chronically homeless by 2016.
- As of December of 2016:
 - 208 homeless veterans housed.
 - 161 chronically homeless individuals housed.

Goals and Update Con't.

- <u>Reached functional zero for chronically</u> <u>homeless veterans.</u>
 - Around 60 homeless veterans remain on the by-name list for housing.

Action Cycle

Learning about and implementing national best practices to:

- Refine by-name list.

- Expand coordinated entry.
- Ultimately, continue to end homelessness by providing services more efficiently and appropriately.
