This indenture made the 22nd., day of July, A.D 1899 between Peter
 G. Christianson, unmarried, of the Town of Deerfield, Dane County,
 Wisconsin, party of the first part and August Mayer, of Shreveport,
 Louisiana, party of the second part witnesseth: that the said party
 of the first part in consideration of the sum of Thirty $\frac{1}{2}$ Dollars,
 to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and confirm unto the said party of the second
 part and to his heirs and assigns forever a right of way in
 and over a ^{certain} strip of land two $\frac{1}{2}$ rods in width on the south
 side of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section
 Twenty-three (23) township seven (7) north, range Twelve (12) east
 being the town of Deerfield, Dane County, Wisconsin and extends
 from the highway touching and abutting on the southeast corner
 of said described Forty (40) acres, across said Forty (40) acres to the
 lands of said August Mayer lying adjacent thereto upon the west
 and north sides of said Forty (40) acres; said right of way
 to be for the said party of the second part his heirs and
 assigns and his and their servants and tenants at all times
 freely to pass and repass on foot or with horses, oxen, cattle
 beasts of burden, wagons, carriages, sleighs or other vehicles
 or carriages whatsoever from the said highway to the
 lands of the said party of the second part as aforesaid
 and from the said lands of the said party of the
 second part to the said highway as aforesaid, as the
 said way is, and shall be forever of the dimensions of
 the strip of land as aforesaid, and the said party
 of the first part further grants to the said party
 of the second part the right to enter upon said

described strip of two (2) rods and repair and maintain the same in good passable condition for the use of travel as aforesaid from said highway to the lands of the party of the second part,

To have and to hold the said easement and privilege to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever as appurtenance belonging to his and their lands as aforesaid and the said Peter G. Christianson, party of the first part for himself and his heirs, representatives and assigns does covenant, grant bargain and agree to and with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns that the above bargained premises and said easements and right of way in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons lawfully claiming the whole or any part thereof, he will forever warrant and defend.
