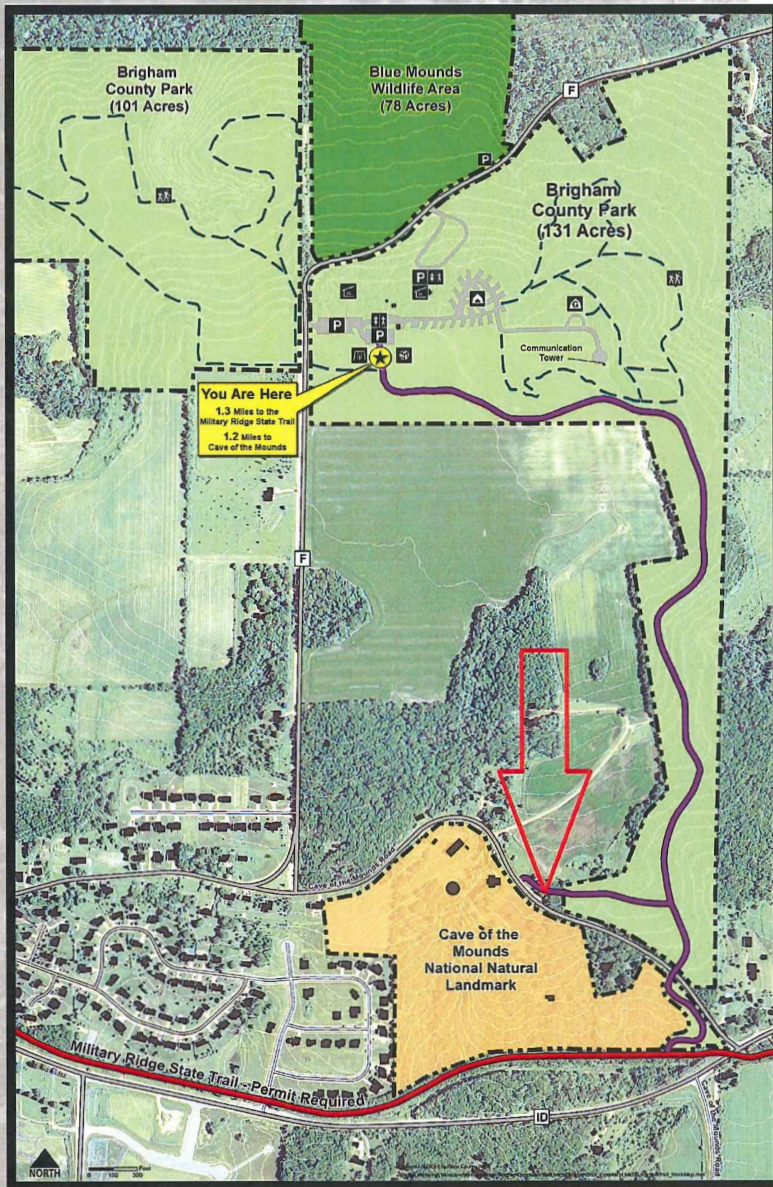




Brigham Trail



ABOUT BRIGHAM COUNTY PARK

- Brigham County Park is a 232 - acre park with a panoramic view of the Wisconsin River Valley.
- It was named after Ebenezer Brigham, who was one of the first to homestead in the area.


PARK RULES

- Park is open daily from 5:00 am to 10:00 pm
- All dogs **MUST** be leashed and their waste removed. All dog owners must purchase a dog permit to bring their dog into the park.
- Vehicles are restricted to designated roadways and parking areas.
- All trash must be removed from the park or deposited in the appropriate containers.
- Fires are allowed in designated areas **ONLY**.
- Please **DO NOT** pick wildflowers or plants, they are for everyone's enjoyment.
- Camping reservations must be made at least 5 days prior to date of use.
- Fireworks and self-propelled rockets are not allowed in the park.
- Hunting in Brigham County Park is by permit **ONLY**.
- Cave of the Mounds National Natural Landmark is privately owned.

LOCK YOUR BELONGINGS

- Riders are responsible for locking unattended bicycles at designated bicycle parking areas
- Dane County is **NOT** responsible for lost or stolen items.
