# AGREEMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CTH M FROM PRAIRIE HILL ROAD TO CROSS COUNTRY ROAD

Between the City of Madison and Dane County

**THIS AGREEMENT**, entered into by and between the City of Madison, a Wisconsin municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Madison") and the County of Dane, a Wisconsin quasi-municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as "County"), is effective as of the date by which all parties have signed hereunder.

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Madison and the County (collectively referred to as the "Parties"), along with the City of Verona ("Verona") and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation ("WisDOT"), have determined that County Trunk Highway ("CTH") M, from Prairie Hill Road to Cross Country Road, located in Madison and Verona (the "Cities"), is in need of reconstruction (the "Project"), and the final design will require contributions from the Parties; and,

- **WHEREAS**, on August 25, 2014, the Parties entered into a cost sharing agreement for the design of the Project; and,
- **WHEREAS**, on April 7, 2015, Madison entered into an agreement with WisDOT to design and construct the Project; and,
- **WHEREAS**, Madison will enter into a separate agreement for cost sharing with Verona; and,
- **WHEREAS**, Madison will enter into a separate agreement for cost sharing with Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District; and,
- **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 66.0301 Wis. Stats., the Parties now wish to formalize arrangements for the local share of the Project's final costs; and,
- **WHEREAS**, funding is to be accomplished in accordance with past policies of cost sharing on similar CTH projects.
- **NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby mutually acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:
- 1. <u>Scope</u>. The Project shall consist of the construction of an improved divided roadway, with sidewalk, off road bike paths, bike lanes, and turn lanes. The Project overview plan is attached hereto as Exhibit A. The street segments of the Project include:
  - a. CTH "M" from Prairie Hill Road to Cross Country Road.

- b. Mid Town Rd from Waterbend Rd to Waldorf Blvd.
- c. CTH PD from 1700' West of CTH M to Meriter Way.
- d. Meriter Way from the CTH PD to Wellness Way.
- e. Wellness Way from Raymond Road to Meriter Way.
- f. Raymond Road from 300' southwest of Wellness Way to 2700' northeast of Wellness Way
- 2. <u>Schedule</u>. The Project is intended to be constructed in 2017, 2018 and 2019.
- 3. <u>Cost Sharing For Construction</u>. Except as otherwise provided for in this Agreement, the Parties agree as follows:
  - a. The Parties agree to joint financial participation in the construction costs for the Project, as set forth in this Agreement and as delineated in the County's "Policy for Joint Projects with Municipalities" adopted May 3, 1999.
  - b. The construction cost for the Project shall consist of both the construction items required to complete the Project and the construction oversight for the Project. The Parties shall share in the construction cost as detailed in Exhibit B. The final cost participation in the project will differ based on the actual cost of constructing the Project and shall be determined by the percentages for the items in which each local government participates as shown in Exhibit B.
  - c. Dane County shall not be required to pay in excess of \$8,500,000 until such time the remaining funds are included in its adopted capital budget.
- 4. <u>Traffic Signals</u>. County agrees to cost share for the operation and maintenance of traffic signals along CTH M. The County shall enter into a separate cost sharing agreement(s) with Madison and Verona for the traffic signals constructed at the locations and percentages provided herein as follows:
  - a. CTH M and CTH PD: ½ Dane County, ¼ City of Madison, ¼ City of Verona.
  - b. CTH M and Mid Town Rd: 1/2 Dane County, 1/2 City of Madison.
- 5. Prior to or concurrent with the approval of the Projects plans, specifications, estimates of cost, and authorization of WisDOT to issue the bid documents, the Parties may execute an addendum to this Agreement which will note additional cost sharing items and the financial commitments of the parties for the Project. Any amendments to this Agreement shall be in writing.
- 6. At the request of the parties, Madison shall manage the Project. Madison shall bill the County for its respective share of the Project costs as specified herein.

- 7. <u>Payment</u>. The County will reimburse Madison, within 60 days of billing, for completed services according to the responsibilities stated above.
- 8. <u>Non-Discrimination</u>. In the performance of the obligations under this Agreement, the parties agree to abide by their own respective affirmative action plans and in doing so agree not to discriminate, in violation of any state or federal law, against any employee or applicant because of race, religion, marital status, age, color, sex, handicap, national origin or ancestry, income level or source of income, arrest record or conviction record, less than honorable discharge, physical appearance, sexual orientation, gender identity, political beliefs, or student status. The parties further agree not to discriminate, in violation of any state or federal law, against any subcontractor or person who offers to subcontract on this Agreement because of race, religion, color, age, disability, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or national origin.
- 9. <u>Liability</u>. Each party shall be responsible for the consequences of its own acts, errors, or omissions and those of its employees, boards, commissions, agencies, officers, and representatives and shall be responsible for any losses, claims, and liabilities which are attributable to such acts, errors, or omissions including providing its own defense. In situations including joint liability, each party shall be responsible for the consequences of its own acts, errors, or omissions and those of its employees, agents, boards, commissions, agencies, officers and representatives. It is not the intent of the parties to impose liability beyond that imposed by state statutes.
- 10. Each party warrants for itself that it has complied with all applicable statutes, rules, orders, ordinances, requirements and regulations to execute this Agreement, and that the person or persons executing this Agreement on its behalf is authorized to do so.
- 11. The Parties may evidence their agreement to the foregoing upon one or several counterparts of this instrument, which together shall constitute a single instrument.




