47 status, except where doing so is based on a reliable, specific description of a suspect
48 and adheres to appropriate Constitutional standards.

49 ***Help our friends, families and neighbors get redress when abuses and mistakes***
50 ***occur:***

51 #8) *Redress Rule:* Any person who alleges a violation of this policy may file a written
52 complaint for investigation with Dane County.

53 ***Help ensure our friends, families, and neighbors are protected from***
54 ***discrimination:***

55 #9) *Fair and Impartial Policing Rule:* No Dane County official shall interrogate, arrest,
56 detain or take other law enforcement action against an individual based upon that
57 individual's perceived race, national origin, religion, language, or immigration status,
58 unless such personal characteristics have been included in timely, relevant, credible
59 information from a reliable source, linking a specific individual to a particular criminal
60 event/activity.

61 Under 8 U.S.C. § 1373 and 8 U.S.C. § 1644, federal law prohibits Dane County
62 officials from imposing limits on maintaining, exchanging, sending, or receiving
63 information regarding citizenship and immigration status with any Federal, State, or
64 local government entity. Nothing in Dane County policies is intended to violate 8
65 U.S.C. § 1373 and 8 U.S.C. § 1644.

66 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Dane County Board of Supervisors supports
67 the ACLU's nine model policies and rules as part of the "Freedom Cities" campaign.
