Brief Description of Proposal -

To accept and approve the 2017 update of Dane County's Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan.

This is the second update of Dane County's Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan. The first version of the plan was adopted in May of 2005, with an update adopted in May of 2010.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

County Board adoption of the plan is required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). Once adopted, the plan will be recognized by FEMA as Dane County's official hazard mitigation plan. This will enable the county to apply for FEMA grant funds to implement eligible projects and programs identified in the plan. The intent is to establish a long-term plan for reducing vulnerability to natural hazards in Dane County.
