5	chanting racist and anti-Semitic sentiments, terrorized the city of Charlottesville, Virginia. As a
6	result of their evil actions, violence erupted and three individuals lost their lives and many others
7	were injured.

- unequivocally condemns the racist, violent actions of the white supremacists and neo-Nazis in

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the hate and bigotry displayed by white supremacists in Charlottesville has no place in our nation, nor do weapons and torches have any place in a

- 18 deepest sympathies to the three individuals who lost their lives in this violence.

- its commitment to fighting for racial and economic justice, gender equality, and human and civilrights for all.
