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DANE COUNTY CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT # 2387

THE ZONING AND LAND REGULATION COMMITTEE OF THE DANE COUNTY BOARD PURSUANT TO SECTION 10.255(2) OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES DOES HEREBY:

GRANT Conditional Use Permit # 2387 for a Kennel within the C-2 Commercial Zoning District pursuant to Dane County Code of Ordinance Section 10.14(2) and subject to any conditions contained herein:

EFFECTIVE DATE OF PERMIT: Pending

THE CONDITIONAL USE SHALL BE LOCATED ON THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

ADDRESS: 202-206 Regas Road, Town of Blooming Grove

PARCEL #: 0710-042-9524-4

Legal Description:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the SE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 4, T07N, R10E, Town of Blooming Grove, thence east along the said northerly quarter line 163 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence east along the said quarter line 184 feet to the west right-of-way line of Regas Road; thence south along Regas road right-of-way 560 feet; thence west 284 feet; thence northeasterly to the point of beginning.

CONDITIONS:

1. The conditional use permit is for operation of a Dog Kennel, Boarding, and Training facility.
2. Any outdoor dog runs shall be fenced.
3. Kennel operation shall have weekly refuse service, with dog waste disposed of in accordance with any applicable state or local guidelines.

THE ZONING AND LAND REGULATION COMMITTEE AFTER PUBLIC HEARING AND IN THEIR CONSIDERATION OF THE CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT MADE THE FOLLOWING FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. That the establishment, maintenance and operation of the proposed conditional use will not be detrimental to or endanger the public health, safety, morals comfort or general welfare.

2. That the uses, values, and enjoyment of other property in the neighborhood for purposes already permitted will not be substantially impaired or diminished by the establishment, maintenance, and operation of the proposed conditional use.
3. That the establishment of the proposed conditional use will not impede the normal and orderly development and improvement of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the district.
4. That adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and other necessary site improvements will be made.
5. That adequate measures will be taken to provide ingress and egress so designed as to minimize traffic congestion in the public streets.
6. That the proposed conditional use does conform to all applicable regulations of the district in which it is proposed to be located.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT

In addition to any time limit established as a condition in granting this CUP, Section 10.25(2)(n) of the Dane County Code of Ordinances provides that any use for which a conditional use permit has been issued, upon its cessation or abandonment for a period of one year, will be deemed to have been terminated and any future use shall be in conformity with the ordinance.
