## AMENDING CHAPTER 25 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, REGARDING LOCALLY OPERATED VENDORS PREFERENCES IN PURCHASING MOTOR VEHICLES FOR THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Dane does ordain as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Unless otherwise expressly stated herein, all references to section and chapter numbers are to those of the Dane County Code of Ordinances.

ARTICLE 2. Section 25.08(11)(k) is amended to read as follows:

(k) For purchases of motor vehicles for the Sheriff's Office, if after reviewing the responses to a sealed bid, the Controller shall review the responses to determine if a Locally Operated Vendor's price is within 15% of the lowest cost bid. If so the Controller will contact the Locally Operated Vendor to determine if the Locally Operated Vendor is willing to offer a price within 5% of the lowest cost bid. If the Locally Operated Vendor is willing to offer a price within 5% of the lowest cost bid. If the Locally Operated Vendor is willing to offer a price within 5% of the lowest cost bid. If the Locally Operated Vendor is willing to offer a price within 5% of the lowest cost bid, then the Locally Operated Vendor shall be awarded the bid. If more than one Locally Operated Vendor has offered a price within 15% of the most responsive bidder, the Locally Operated Vendor declines to offer a price will be contacted first. If the first Locally Operated Vendor to determine that vendor's interest in offering a price within 5% of the most responsive bidder, then the Controller will contact the next highest bidding Locally Operated Vendor to determine that vendor's interest in offering a price within 5% of the most responsive bidder.

[EXPLANATION: This amendment revises the terminology for providing preferences in purchasing motor vehicles for the Sheriff's Office to locally operated vendors.]
