<u>PLSR.</u> PLSR work continues for all teams. Much attention is being paid to the details of models. Continuing Education/Consulting Team is working on staffing levels and regional placement of servicesflushing out our model and preparing for presentation at this year's Wisconsin Library Association in the Wisconsin Dells. Beyond the Page. Efforts continue to plan a county-wide event for 2021. <u>ILS demos.</u> I attended the first of three 3-day demos of ILS systems being considered by SCLS. Polaris was demonstrated in Prairie du Sac smack dab during our move. It is an impressive product. The next demo is of Sirsi/Dynix on October 3-5 and will be at SCLS. The final demo is Koha and will be after WLA.
