<sup>(1)</sup> The Administration's baseline was the FY 2017 CR, so does not reflect final funding for FY 2017, which included increases for some core OAA programs. Therefore "level" funding appears as a cut on our chart for accuracy, but we do not believe that was the intention. (2) The Administration budget and House Labor-HHS proposal eliminate SHIP funding, citing program duplication with 1-800-MEDICARE. (3) The budget eliminates the PPHF and moves CDSMP and Falls Prevention under ACL discretionary appropriations. (4) Funding for Alzheimer's programs is consolidated under the Alzheimer's Disease Program. (5) SMP will be "fully funded" at the discretion of the HHS secretary. Total funding for the HCFAC/SMP account is set at \$18 million, but it is as yet unclear what final funding for SMP will be. (6) The House Labor-HHS bill proposes moving SCSEP from DOL to ACL.
