## Key Findings for Dane County

- While Dane County's population has steadily increased over time, jail admission rates, as well as average daily population have declined relative to the rate of population growth since 2006
- 2016 has the lowest ADP Rate per 100,000 residents (Incarceration Rate) since 1990.

## Calculations

The slight increase in the Dane County Population affects the trend line for the ADP rate
These were the calculations for the trend line.

| Year | ADP | Population | Calculation | Resulting Value |
| :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- |
| 2014 | 875 | 502984 | $(875 / 502984)^{*} 100,000$ | $=173.96$ |
| 2015 | 875 | 510198 | $(875 / 510198)^{*} 100,000$ | $=171.50$ |

The ADP rate per 100 K residents line appears to be on a downward trend, despite the numbers being exactly the same for both years.
