HHN-O-02 Increase GPR by \$50,000 for AAA Case Management – add sponsors: Downing, Kilmer, Veldran, Zweifel. Motion by Levin to approve, seconded by Zweifel. Motion by Wegleitner to postpone to November 1, seconded by Veldran. Motion to postpone failed 3 (Wegleitner, Veldran, Kilmer)-3 (Levin, Zweifel, Young) Motion to approve carried 5 (Levin, Zweifel, Kilmer, Young, Veldran)-0-1 (Wegleitner abstained), YGP 1-0

HHN-O-03 Add language to Res 252 for \$100,000 mental health services system review – Motion by Levin to approve, seconded by Zweifel. Motion by Wegleitner to postpone to November 1, seconded by Kilmer. Motion to postpone failed 1 (Wegleitner)-5 (Levin, Zweifel, Young, Veldran, Kilmer). Wegleitner moved that the proposed RFP language shall be approved by the County Board and referred to Human Services Committees. Motion failed for lack of a second. Motion by Young, seconded by Levin to amend to add language to reach out to community partners and stakeholders during the drafting of the RFP and take into consideration any prior legislation in this regard. Motion to approve as amended carried 6 (Levin, Zweifel, Wegleitner, Kilmer, Young, Veldran)-0, YGP 1-0

HHN-O-04 Increase GPR \$1,300 for Sensitive Crimes Commission LTE's – Motion by Young to approve, seconded by Levin. Motion to approve carried 6 (Levin, Zweifel, Wegleitner, Kilmer, Young, Veldran)-0, YGP 1-0

HHN-O-05 Increase GPR \$35,000 for Sexual Assault Prevention RFP – add sponsors: Zweifel, Kilmer, Veldran, Levin. Motion by Young to approve, seconded by Levin. Motion by Veldran to postpone to November 1, seconded by Wegleitner. Motion failed 2 (Veldran, Wegleitner)-4 (Levin, Zweifel, Kilmer, Young). YGP 0-1. Motion to approve carried 6 (Levin, Zweifel, Wegleitner, Kilmer, Young, Veldran)-0, YGP 1-0
