This will include enough information to ensure that the pipeline capacity is sized appropriately for the demonstrated digester demand at that time and for anticipated future growth. Staff will also brief the committees about the potential to generate additional revenue by sizing the pipeline for anticipated future growth in the biogas sector, thereby demonstrating an appropriate return on investment."

<b>Intent/Justification</b>			
<p>The goals of the biogas offloading station are to strengthen the agricultural economy and protect water quality, as well as to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and advance domestically produced alternative fuels. Digester owners would need to take steps required to ready methane for the pipeline and truck it to the offloading station site. Prior to investing \$5.5 million in building the offloading station, digester owners should sign an agreement indicating their intent to use the pipeline, including a timeline and estimated volume of CNG to be injected into the pipeline. This will allow the county to make an informed decision regarding the capacity of the biogas offloading station.</p>

The Fund will continue to be administered by the Office of Economic and Workforce Development. Up to \$1 million of the 2018 allocation will be available to fund and RFP response by the Dane County Housing Authority. The RFP will be coordinated and reviewed by a staff team including the Director of the Office of Economic and Workforce Development, the Controller, the Director of Planning and Development and a staff person from the Human Services Department. Meetings of the staff team will be open to the public and agendas will be posted in the county's Legistar system. The staff team will present their recommendations of funding awards to the Personnel and Finance Committee prior to introducing an award resolution."</p>
