ACCEPTING REVENUE FROM THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES AUTHORIZING NEW POSITIONS FOR COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY SERVICES (CCS) DCDHS - ACS AND CYF DIVISIONS

#### **Policy Analysis Statement:**

#### Brief Description of Proposal -

Dane County Department of Human Services (DCDHS) has been certified to provide Comprehensive Community Services since July 1, 2015. Comprehensive Community Services (CCS) is a Medicaid mental health recovery benefit that is available to children, youth and adults who are Medicaid eligible, and pass a required functional screen. This resolution seeks to add two (2) social work positions to provide CCS Service Facilitation for dually eligible CCS and CLTS children and youth and one (1) social work supervisor to supervise the CCS intake unit.

#### Current Policy or Practice -

Budget changes require County Board approval.

# Impact of Adopting Proposal -

This resolution adds 2 FTE social work positions to provide CCS service facilitation for dually eligible CCS and CLTS children and youth. Both positions will be allocated to payroll code 4455 in the Department's Children Youth and Families Division. These positions will be fully funded by CCS. This resolution also seeks to add 1 FTE social work supervisor position to supervise the CCS intake unit and meet the required mental health professional review and sign off in the enrollment process. Currently Dane County has 137 children and 510 adults enrolled in our CCS Program.

# Narrative/Assumptions about long range fiscal effect:

Funding comes from the CCS benefit in Medicaid. Revenue is earned after services are provided. CCS services and positions are fully funded by Medicaid, no local match is required. If additional CCS service facilitators are not hired, DCDHS will be unable to provide services to children and youth who are entitled to receive them. If a social work supervisor is not hired, the quality of the intakes being conducted and the quality of the CCS network as a whole will suffer. This could leave the DCDHS vulnerable to audit exceptions in connection with certification reviews of this program.
