1. Friends of Silverwood Park Lease

Hicklin provide information on the current leases for Silverwood County Park, two agricultural leases with farmers Rademacher and Doudlah, along with an 18-acre lease with the Friends Silverwood. The Friends of Silverwood use their lands for demonstration and educational purposes. The friends are interested in expanding their leased acreage by an additional 38 acres or so. After discussions with the Friends group, staff are supportive of undertaking the additional acreage. Kyle Richmond, President of the Friends of Silverwood, spoke in support of the proposed lease, stating that any revenue received by the Friends in association with the lease would be used directly at the Park to help implement the master plan. Richmond provided a handout with the Friends' programming goals for the acreage.

LUNNEY requested that if the proposed lease moves forward there will need to be an annual report to the Commission that includes how the lease dollars are being allocated to advance the park master plan and programming at the park.
