2017 General WSP activities

- 90 Winter Spreading Permits covering 40,561 Acres (6 CAFO's with acres not included)
- 2 new permittee's in 2017 covering 1,126.6 Acres
- 31 permits (re)issued in 2017 on 18,315.4 Acres

2017-2018 WSP Status Reviews

22 Permit selected for status reviews

2 Permittee's no longer have cattle

8 reviews complete

5 permittee's no liquid manure applications to date

3 permittee's applications documented with logs and conservation practice, field verified conservation practice

653,937 gallons applied to 128.3 acres for an average application rate of 5,097 gal/ac.

Status Review Process

Fall - Letter telling they have been selected for a status review and reminding them to review their:

- restriction maps
- Spills/Runoff Emergency Response Plan
- Implement a conservation Practice
- Track all applications of liquid manure

Review in mid-late February to increase the likely-hood there have been manure applications to fields

- Make them show us their permit with maps
- Review requirements of their permit and make updates if necessary
- Review any spreading logs
- Look at fields where applications have taken place to confirm implementation of setbacks and practices
