

• Health & medical problems (please use non-medical terms): <u>This client has the following medical</u> conditions: Asthma, emphysema, heart problems, abdominal pain, diabetes, esophageal reflux extreme heartburn), high blood pressure, stroke in 2011, osteoarthritis, vitamin B12 deficiency, ulcer on ankle, and sleep apnea (tongue muscle relaxes to the point the airway is blocked).

• Situation requiring rehabilitation and desired outcomes: <u>This client was admitted to St. Mary's Hospital</u> on December 11^h, 2017 for a broken foot and pressure sore on right ankle. The client broke her right foot in 3 places while using her wheelchair in the kitchen. Instead of going backwards she accidently drove her wheelchair forward and her right foot was stuck between the cabinet drawers casuing the fratures. On December 17, 2017, she was transferred to Middleton Village Nursing Home for additional health care and appropriate rehab services as recommended by the doctor. This client is currently using a power w/c for mobility. She is also working on gaining more strength in her arms, hands, and legs in order to be able to transfer in and out of her wheelchair to her bed safely and independently at home. The client is also receiving I.V. therapy for infections on right ankle. She will return to the community as soon as she finishes her I.V. treatment on Friday, January 26, 2018 and reaches the above PT/OT goals. CLA CIP II Program will continue to provide case management services with appropriate health care service providers. Middleton Village Nursing Home Staff, and this client for up to 90 days from the above admission date.
