A business walk is an economic development initiative that, in a short amount of time, allows local leaders to get the pulse of how a business community is doing. Following the presentation, the Commission discussed the potential for a business walk sponsored or co-sponsored by Dane County this summer. The City of Madison is hosting a business walk on April 18th for businesses along the Park Street and Regent Street corridors. County staff and ED Commissioners are encouraged to volunteer to assist in outreach and to gain better insight to the business walk program.
