Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

The Dane County Office of Energy and Climate Change (OECC) has successfully solicited and acquired a grant for \$29,500 from the Carolyn Foundation primarily to support the modeling work being performed by Sustainable Energy Economics to support the CAP development. The 2018 OECC budget included \$20,000 for modeling that will total \$80,000; the Carolyn Foundation grant is matching funds that OECC pledged to raise in this fiscal year.
