2019 Budget Target

- Overall Directive:
 - Cost to continue (\$17,203,787, plus adjustments)
- Fund Balance
 - Application of fund balance revised to \$750,000 (pending approval) in 2019 to offset lost revenue (specifically in the Lab and WIC programs)
- City of Madison
 - Target: \$5,291,194
- Dane County
 - Target: \$6,240,989
- Remaining portion of the target made up of fees, grants, and contracts (\$6,511,084)
