## 1 2018 RES-165 AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF TRAINING GRANT TO CONDUCT HAZMAT TOXIC 2 MEDIC TRAINING 3 4 The HazMat Division of the Department of Emergency Management has been awarded a training grant from Wisconsin Emergency Management (WEM) in the amount of \$9,875 to 5 conduct training for county firefighters while operating as a "medic" considerations relative to 6 7 toxic patients/environments. This training is a 1-day class offered three times to cover all 8 operational shifts. This class will cover/discuss toxicology, assessment, diagnosis and treatment for those responders providing medical care to include appropriate delivery methods, 9 symptomology and treatment modalities. 10
