2018 URBAN WATER QUALITY GRANT AWARDS

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

The Dane County Urban Water Quality Grant Program was included in the 2018 budget to improve the quality of urban stormwater runoff entering Dane County lakes, rivers and streams, increase public awareness of urban water quality issues, and provide public education for urban stormwater quality improvement practices. The Land & Water Resources Department recommends projects from Madison, Stoughton, Sun Prairie, Oregon, Verona & Middleton. Current Policy or Practice -

Urban Water Quality Grant awards require County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The project goals are to be achieved through the construction of best management practices that will provide efficient, cost-effective treatment of urban runoff. The grant awards are contingent on the County and project sponsor entering into a grant agreement that will specify the program requirements and applicable grant conditions for each project. The grant awards total \$662,527 and the funds are currently available in the 2018 Legacy Fund.
