The annual award will be presented to those individuals, schools, youth and adult organizations, civic organizations and other organizations that have volunteered their time and effort to preserve, protect or plant trees. Project must have been completed in calendar year 2018 or, if a continuing project, have been started in 2018 and have an anticipated life of more than one year. Examples of projects that are nominated include: tree preservation actions, development of comprehensive forestry policy, provided education programs on trees, tree planting projects, and integration of natural resource issues into local and regional planning initiatives and development of tree maintenance programs. An *“Outstanding Individual Friends of the Forest Award”* may be awarded to any individual(s) who displays superior tree preservation and/or planting attitudes and actions.

Instructions:

Applicants must submit a written description of the project or program, benefits to the communities within Dane County, the planning involved, how problems were addressed and how the project will meet the Dane County Tree Board's Mission. Applicants should submit photographs or materials to illustrate the project. Please limit your application to four pages: this form and a maximum of three additional pages, including photographs and illustrations
