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Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Emergency Management has been awarded a training grant from Wisconsin Emergency Management (WEM) in the amount of \$9,875 to hire a nationally recognized trainer to conduct HazMat Toxic Medic training for area firefighters. This 1-day class will be offered three times (once per shift) covering toxicology, assessment, diagnosis and treatment for responders to quickly asses the medical delivery methods, symptomology and treatment modalities.
