Awarding a collective bargaining agreement to the Dane County WPPA Supervisory Law Enforcement Unit

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

This resolution approves the terms and conditions of a one-year successor agreement between Dane County and the WPPA Supervisory Law Enforcement Unit. The County employs approximately 46 full time equivalent employees in this bargaining unit. The agreement includes hourly wage increases, UPAY increase, education incentive pay changes, and increases to the vacation and sick leave banks. The new agreement will expire on December 8, 2018.

Current Policy or Practice -

The current agreement with the unit expired on December 9, 2017.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The agreement includes a 1.25% hourly wage increase in PP1, and increase of UPAY to \$.80 per hour, a modification to the educational incentive pay and increases to the sick and vacation banks.
