*i.* Jon Becker spoke in support of returning lake levels to natural levels and to expanding the scope of the resolution to include issues such as wetland protection, beyond flooding.

ii. Eric Katte spoke in support of Res 227 and commented that lake levels are managed too high and that the County has not managed levels within the DNR target range.
iii. Supervisor Heidi Wegleitner spoke in support of Res 227 and asked that the language be amended to include a more aggressive timeline, to incorporate public health review and comments, and to include more opportunities for public oversight.
iv.
