Amending Chapter 62 of the Dane County Code of Ordinances, revising the Medical Examiner's Fees

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

The ordinance amendment increases the fee for services related to issuing a cremation certificate to \$291.00. The amendment also increases the morgue use fee paid by tissue procurement agencies from \$1250.00. Finally, the ordinance removes language that created a fee associated with medical certification of a death established in May / June of 2015 which was negated by a post dated amendment of State Statute 59.365 in 2015.

Current Policy or Practice -

The County currently charges \$285.00 for a cremation examination and permit issuance. The County currently charges tissue procurement agencies \$1200.00 for a morgue use fee.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The increase in the cremation examination and permit issuance fee will generate an estimated additional \$14000.00. The increase in the morgue use fee will generate between \$4000.00 and \$5000.00.
