AMENDING CHAPTER 12 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, MODIFYING ZONING FEES

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Dane does ordain as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Unless otherwise expressly stated herein, all references to section and chapter numbers are to those of the Dane County Code of Ordinances.

ARTICLE 2. Section 12.03 is amended to read as follows:

12.03 ZONING PERMIT FEES FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION, ADDITIONS AND

ALTERA-TIONS. (1) For construction of new single family, duplex and mobile home residences, the fee shall be \$50.00 plus \$0.0175 for each square foot of floor area, including basements and attached garages. Late Filing Fee: Where work has begun before a permit has been obtained the fee shall be doubled.

(2) For additions to or alterations of existing single family, duplex and mobile home

residences, and for buildings accessory to single family, duplex and mobile home 19 residences, the fee shall be \$50.00 plus \$0.0175 for each square foot of added floor area, including basements and attached garages. Late Filing Fee: Where work has

21 begun before a permit has been obtained the fee shall be doubled.

22 (3) For construction of commercial structures and multi-family residences, including 23 additions, alterations and accessory buildings, the fee shall be \$200.00250.00 plus

24 \$2.00 for each \$1,000 of construction costs or fraction thereof. Late Filing Fee: Where work has begun before a permit has been obtained the fee shall be doubled.

26 (4) Measurements are to be made using outside dimensions. When computed, the fee amount shall be rounded to the nearest dollar.

28 (5) The fee for all new construction, alterations and additions to existing buildings and 29 buildings used for agricultural purposes where a permit is required because of locational 30 requirements of the board of adjustment shall be \$80.00, except as otherwise provided 31 above. Late Filing Fee: Where work has begun before a permit has been obtained the fee shall be doubled.

33 (6) Cost of construction shall include the cost of mechanical equipment, but shall not 34 include the cost of manufacturing or processing equipment or machinery, site preparation, sewage disposal systems, utility lines or landscaping.

(7) The fee for a zoning permit for equipment replacement or modification, or colocation of equipment on an existing cell tower or other structure shall be \$500.

- ARTICLE 3. Section 12.05 is amended to read as follows:

40 **12.05 OTHER PERMIT AND REVIEW FEES.** (1) The fee for a petition to amend the 41 zoning maps in the M-1, C-1, or C-2 districts shall be \$500.00. The fee for a petition to 42 amend the zoning maps in all other districts shall be \$350.00. Late Filing Fee: Where 43 work has begun before a permit has been obtained, or where a change in the use of the 44 property has occurred which requires a change in zoning district, or where necessary 45 approvals have not been obtained prior to commencing a change in use, the fee shall 46 be doubled.

47 (a) The zoning administrator shall collect an additional fee of $\frac{36.0045.00}{36.0045.00}$ when the 48 petition, if granted, will result in a change to the zoning map. 49 (b) The zoning administrator shall collect an additional fee of \$100.00 for a density 50 study when the petition includes a request to rezone from the A-1 Exclusive Agriculture 51 zoning district. 52 (c) The zoning administrator shall collect an additional fee of \$100 per lot when the 53 petition requests a rezone for a subdivision comprised of five or more lots. The 54 maximum fee under this subsection shall not exceed \$2,800 per subdivision. 55 (d) The zoning administrator shall collect an additional fee of \$125145.00 when the 56 petition includes land in the shoreland-wetland or inland-wetland districts. 57 (3)(a) Except as provided in section 12.05(2)(b) and subs. (b) and (c) herein, the fee for 58 an application for a conditional use permit shall be \$450.00. Late Filing Fee: Where 59 work has begun before a permit has been obtained, or where appropriate approvals 60 have not been obtained prior to commencing a change in use which requires a 61 conditional use permit, the fee shall be doubled. 62 (b) The fee for an application for a conditional use permit for the construction, 63 placement or modification of a communication tower under section 10.194 of this code 64 of ordinances shall be \$1,100.00. Late Filing Fee: Where work has begun before a permit has been obtained or appropriate approvals obtained the fee shall be doubled. 65 66 (c) The fee for an application for a conditional use permit for a mineral extraction operation shall be \$1,100.00. Late Filing Fee: Where work has begun before a permit 67 68 has been obtained or appropriate approvals are obtained the fee shall be doubled. 69 (d) In addition to the fees set forth in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c), there is imposed a 70 digital mapping maintenance fee of \$36.0045.00. 71 (e) In addition to the fees set forth in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), and (d), there is imposed 72 a digital mapping maintenance fee of \$36.0045.00. 73 The fee for Radio Frequency Engineering review of an application for a conditional (f) 74 use permit for the construction, placement or modification of a communication tower 75 under section 10.194 of this code of ordinances shall be \$3,000 per communication tower plus the cost of any additional services rendered as established in current 76 77 Purchase of Service (POS) agreement for these services. 78 (4) The fee for an application for a variance shall be \$350.00500.00. Late Filing Fee: 79 Where work has begun before a permit has been obtained or appropriate approvals 80 obtained the fee shall be doubled. 81 (5) The fee for an appeal to the board of adjustment of an administrator's decision 82 shall be \$350.00500.00. (6) The fee for a certificate of compliance for buildings constructed prior to August 20, 83 84 1970, and all other certificates provided for in chapter 10 shall be \$45.0050.00. (7) The fee for a salvage yard license or renewal shall be \$125.00150.00. 85 (9) The fee for each zoning certificate under the Wisconsin Farmland Preservation Act 86 87 shall be \$30.00. 88 (a) Whenever a farm is located in two townships and two certificates are required, only 89 one fee shall be charged. 90 (12) The fee for an administrative determination of the flood plain status of a parcel of 91 land shall be \$125.00145.00.

92 (13) The fee for an administrative determina-tion of the navigability or ordinary high 93 water mark of any lake, pond, flowage, river or stream shall be \$125.00145.00. 12.06(

- 94 (14) The fee for a preliminary density study shall be \$100.00120.00. A preliminary density study is a study conducted by the department to determine the number of splits remaining for a particular parcel or to analyze other components of a town plan, performed where the person requesting the study does not have a zoning petition pending.
- 99 (15) The fee for review of a general development plan (GDP) required under s. 10.152
- 100 || shall be \$400.001,000.00 plus \$5.00 for every acre proposed for development, inclusive
