Community Safety Intervention Team (CSIT)

- Group of key organizational stakeholders who care about community violence.
- Share information and develop strategies which will serve to mitigate and repair the harm violence causes in our community.
- Attend a biweekly meeting and share information as to how community violence is impacting our organizations. We then return our organizations and work on the development and implementation of shared strategies to reduce community violence.

Public Health Framework

- Data-driven: approaches based on data that describe the nature of the problem as well as contributing risk and resilience factors
- Collaborative: multiple partners from public health, law enforcement, human services, education, recreation, economic development, mental health, substance abuse, business, and others working together to produce change
- Population-based: seeking community wide or environmental solutions
- Primary prevention: efforts designed to prevent violence before it occurs
