## SUB 1 to 2018 RES-420 URGING ALLOCATION OF SPACE FOR SPIRITUAL CONTEMPLATION IN THE CONSOLIDATED DANE COUNTY JAIL

In 2017, Dane County approved the consolidation of its three jail facilities into a single building. The consultants Mead and Hunt are currently designing a structure to be located on West Wilson Street to adjoin the Public Safety Building. The consolidated jail will have almost 100 fewer beds than the three existing facilities. It will also include space for medical services, youthful inmate housing, and programs and activities.

There has been recent discussion of the importance of <u>communal</u> spiritual <u>services/activities</u> reflection—for those who are incarcerated, to meet their psycho-social, spiritual and emotional needs and lift their spirits. It is important for the consolidated jail to have a space available for the practice of all spiritual traditions, as well as other personal growth programs, e.g. tutoring, recovery groups, parenting, etc, and the design of such a space should take into account the desire to be inclusive. While some have advocated for inclusion of a chapel in the design of the new facility, others point out that a broader and more inclusive conception of a spiritual space would be appropriate.

The design of the consolidated jail must balance competing needs. It may be necessary for a multi-purpose space to serve as a place of contemplation at scheduled times, rather than being available solely for this use.

 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors recognizes the right of people who are incarcerated to have equitable access to attend personal and/or communal spiritual services/activites according to their respective spiritual traditions and practices and in compliance with Federal guidelines; and hereby urge expresses our desire that the Sheriff work with his office and any relevant consultants, along with Mead and Hunt, to ensure that space for communal spiritual practices is included in identify ways to accommodate space for this activity within the design and construction of the consolidated jail
