2	URGING ALLOCATION OF SPACE FOR SPIRITUAL CONTEMPLATION
3	IN THE CONSOLIDATED DANE COUNTY JAIL
4	
5	In 2017, Dane County approved the consolidation of its three jail facilities into a single
6	building.
7	The consultants Mead and Hunt are currently designing a structure to be located on West
8	Wilson Street to adjoin the Public Safety Building. The consolidated jail will have almost 100
9	fewer beds than the three existing facilities. It will also include space for medical
10	services, youthful inmate housing, and programs and activities.
11	
12	There has been recent discussion of the importance of spiritual reflection for those who
13	are incarcerated. While some have advocated for inclusion of a chapel in the design of
14	the new facility, others point out that a broader and more inclusive conception of a spiritual
15	space would be appropriate. communal services/activities for those who are incarcerated, to
16	meet their psychological, social and emotional needs. It is important for the consolidated jail
17	to have a space available for personal growth programs or other group activities, e.g.
18	tutoring, religious gatherings, mutual support groups, group study, parenting, etc., and the
19	design of such a space should take into account the desire to be inclusive. The space shall
20	<u>be decorated and maintained in a manner that does not favor one group or use over any</u>
21	<u>other.</u>
22	
23	The design of the consolidated jail must balance competing needs. It may be necessary
24	for a multi-purpose space to serve as a place of contemplation at scheduled times, rather
25	than being available solely for this use.
26	
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors
28	recognizes the importance of affording individuals the opportunity to choose to engage in
29	spiritual reflection, and hereby expresses our desire that the Sheriff work with his office
30	and any consultants, including Mead and Hunt, to identify ways to accommodate space
31	for this activity within the design and construction of the consolidated jail. <u>right of people</u>
32	who are incarcerated to have equitable access to attend personal growth programs
33	including: communal spiritual services/activities according to their respective traditions and
34	practices in compliance with federal guidelines, tutoring, recovery groups, support groups,
35	parenting, anger management, etc. and hereby urge the Sheriff work with his office and
36	relevant consultants, along with Mead and Hunt, to ensure that space for personal growth
37	programs is included in the design and construction of the consolidated jail.
