The Land & Water Resources Department – Parks Division has secured a \$146,751 grant from
 the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) Recreational Trails Grant Program
 for the resurfacing of the Capital City State Trail.

8

9.5 miles of the Capital City State Trail are managed by Dane County Parks per a cooperative
agreement with WDNR. The County has planned a phased project to resurface the trail. In
2018, 6 miles of the trail were resurfaced, culverts replaced, ADA compliant detectable warning
panels were installed at crossings, and signage updates were completed with the
implementation of the Capital City Trail Wayfinding Plan. This phase includes resurfacing the

14 trail segment from Fish Hatchery Road to Seminole Highway.
