ESTABLISHING THE DANE COUNTY 2020 CENSUS COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE

5 The United States Constitution requires a census of the population every ten years. The U. S. Census counts people of all ages, races, ethnic groups, and citizens and non-6 7 citizens. Population totals from the decennial Census determine the number of seats 8 each state has in the United States House of Representatives and are used to redraw 9 state legislative districts, county supervisory districts, and municipal aldermanic districts. 10 Census information is also used to determine the appropriation of approximately \$675 11 billion in federal funds for state and local programs.

13 Earlier this month, the U.S. Census Bureau announced its communications campaign platform, "Shape your future. START HERE." In 2020, for the first time the U.S. Census 14 15 will make self-reporting available online. Phone and paper surveys will continue.

17 The Complete Count Committee is a group of diverse community leaders appointed by 18 the County Executive for the purpose of developing and implementing a comprehensive 19 2020 Census awareness campaign in partnership with the U.S. Census Bureau. 20 Communities throughout the country have begun forming these committees, including 21 the cities of Madison and Middleton. Dane County will coordinate with municipal 22 committees, and will focus geographically outside of Madison. Additionally, the county 23 will identify areas with a low initial response for the 2010 census and will focus on 24 improving the response for 2020.

The goals of the Dane County 2020 Census Complete Count Committee are to:

ensure an accurate count of every resident,

- ensure an accurate count of most likely undercounted communities,
- achieve a high return of online, phone, and mailed Census surveys,
- make every resident aware of the Census, and
- 32 make every resident aware that the information they provide for the Census is • 33 kept in complete confidence.

35 NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Dane County recognizes the importance of 36 the 2020 Census and, to guarantee the most accurate count of county residents as possible, hereby establishes the Dane County 2020 Census 37 Complete Count 38 Committee.

40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Dane County Executive appoint the Dane County 41 2020 Census Complete Count Committee consisting of community leaders from 42 throughout Dane County, particularly those representing historically undercounted 43 individuals including the homeless, young children, and the Latino and Hmong 44 population.

46 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that staff support to the Dane County 2020 Census 47 Complete Count Committee be provided by the Department of Planning and 48 Development.
