Jon Becker, representing CRANES, asked that the task force report be amended to address the following points: 1. Using soil borings or other data to determine the historic lake levels, prior to development of the Tenney Dam, 2. Avoid the fish weir when dredging, 3. Identify the emergency powers of the County to manage outside of the DNR order, 4. Request the DNR to share the science behind the 1979 lake order, 5. Identify how public comments to the task force were considered by the task force, and 6. Provide explanation of how the task force members were appointed. He also asked that all public meetings be live streamed. Supervisor Chenoweth asked that the task force report be amended to add Dunkirk dam to the list of dams that should be jointly coordinated. Chair RITT noted that the task force recommendations were on the agenda as a report to the committee to make committee members aware that the task force had completed its task and that the recommendations are available for review.
