- Coordinate special accommodation requests
- Provide and coordinate additional services
 - Covering WI
 - Health Insurance Assistance
 - Exemptions, options for health care



Volunteers

- 60 preparers
- 14 greeters
- Used local small businesses for volunteer appreciation events



Accomodations

- ADRC Wheelchair
- ASL interpreting service
- Spanish speaking staff and 2 Spanish speaking volunteers
- Hmong speaking volunteer
- UW Extension's Language Line



Observations (Covering WI)

- There were numerous people applying for the hardship exemption due to homelessness and domestic violence.
- Many taxpayers stated employer covered insurance was too expensive
- Many folks appeared to qualify for Badger Care but had never applied
- Many seniors were not well informed on how to get supplemental coverage



Observations (Karina)

- Changing Latinx demographics
- Tax implications for side jobs
- Credit invisibility



Take-aways

- Increase community resource offerings
- Expand outreach for even more diverse volunteers
- Opportunity for educating persons new to this country on taxes, banking systems and other financial services
