The housing advocates spoke in favor of both sections. One written comment was submitted and is attached to the minutes.

The staff team reviewed and discussed evaluation criteria and percentage weight of each requirement. Motion by Hicklin, seconded by Becker, to set the scoring criteria to the following weighted percentages of each section: 4.4-5% 4.5-10% 4.5-25% 4.5-25% 4.6-5% 4.7-10% 4.8-10% 4.9-10% 4.10-20%

Motion passed unanimously by a voice vote.

Motion by Hicklin, seconded by Violante, to incorporate any changes that result from the meeting between the housing advocacy group and developers into the RFP. Hicklin and Becker will attend the meeting to be held on Monday, May 13. Motion passed unanimously by a voice vote.
