Bayrd explains that Executive Committee is offering to fund small studies to evaluate county processes or issues. Invites members to share ideas.

Rusk suggests that the committee review last year's budget audit of JMHC to determine if it is being completed and if so whether it needs to be supplemented in order to obtain a comprehensive review of JMHC's services.

Bayrd suggests that a review of last year's budget should take place regardless of the Executive Committee's funding.

Bayrd suggests studying alternatives to incarceration programs that are successful in other counties for people of color.

Krause supports a study of what is contributing to the recent rash of car thefts by juveniles.
