## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO THE RESIDENTS OF DANE COUNTY, WISCONSIN

Notice is hereby given that a representative of the Housing Authority of Dane County, Wisconsin (the "Authority") will hold a public hearing at 1:00 p.m. on April 25, 2019 in the offices of the Authority located at 6000 Gisholt Drive, Suite 203, Monona, Wisconsin 53713, regarding the proposed issuance by the Authority of revenue bonds, at one or more times in one or more series, pursuant to Sections 59.53(22) and 66.1201 to 66.1211 of the Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, in a maximum aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$8,500,000, on behalf of Madison Development Corporation, a Wisconsin nonprofit corporation. The bonds would finance (i) the construction of a 44-unit multifamily apartment facility located at 1954 East Washington Street, Madison, Wisconsin (the "Parcel"), and (ii) the refurbishing and rehabilitation of an existing 32-unit facility (comprised of a 28-unit and an annexed 4-unit structure) for purposes of a multifamily apartment facility, located on Lot 1 of the same Parcel. The initial owner of the facilities will be Madison Development Corporation.

The public hearing will be conducted in a manner that provides a reasonable opportunity to be heard for persons with differing views on both issuance of the bonds and the location and nature of the proposed facilities. Any person desiring to be heard on this matter is requested to attend the public hearing or send a representative. Written comments (not exceeding 250 words) to be considered at the hearing may be submitted to the Authority.

Comments made at the hearing are for the consideration of the County Board of Dane County, Wisconsin.
