**Dream Bus Reporting – 1<sup>st</sup> month**

We had 1,151 visits, 75 new library cards issued and 722 items checked out in the first month of service.

For Summer Reading Program we have an intern from Boys and Girls Club that will help kids sign up for summer reading, keep statistics, and hand out prizes. We will also have a “maker intern” who will manage craft/makerspace projects. Fitchburg Youth Services staff will provide summer reading program at Leopold Park; Sun Prairie Youth Staff will provide summer reading at the Sun Prairie stops.

I have invoiced Madison, Fitchburg and Sun Prairie for 1<sup>st</sup> quarter expenses; they have all sent us payment. I’m currently working on the 2020 Dream Bus budget.


**Friends report.** No report; will plan to hold a phone meeting in July.
