DEDICATION OF THE WILLIAM G. LUNNEY LAKE FARM COUNTY PARK

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

William (Bill) G. Lunney served in County government for fifty years, starting as a County Board Supervisor in 1969 and culminating as Park Commission Chair in 2019. Bill served on the Dane County Park Commission for 32 years (1987 – 2019), including 30 years as Chair. Under Bill's leadership, the Dane County Park system has grown to over 15,000 acres of protected lands throughout Dane County and welcomes over 3 million visitors per year.

Current Policy or Practice -

Dedication of parkland in recognition of a person(s) is generally publicly recognized through a resolution.

Lake Farm County Park shall be dedicated from here on after as the William G. Lunney Lake Farm County Park.
