ACCEPTANCE OF A WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES GRANT FOR
CAPITAL CITY STATE TRAIL BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

The Land & Water Resources Department – Parks Division has secured a \$74,308 grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) Urban Rivers Grant Program for a bridge replacement during resurfacing of the Capital City State Trail.

9.5 miles of the Capital City State Trail are managed by Dane County Parks per a cooperative agreement with WDNR. The County has planned a phased project to resurface the trail. In 2018, 6-miles of the trail were resurfaced during phase one. In 2019, the county plans to complete phase two of the resurfacing on the trail segment from Fish Hatchery Road to Seminole Highway. This phase will include the bridge replacement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept the \$74,308 grant from the WI DNR,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that revenue account LEWSLUNY 80069 and expenditure account LEWSLUNY 58823 Capital Trail Rehab be increased \$74,308. All Funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.
