Dane County and Landkreis Kassel in the state of Hessen, Germany 7 established a sister county relationship. Cultural exchange has been a vital aspect of this partnership. In September, 2019 the Edgar Knecht Trio will visit Dane County, offering concerts 8 for the community, as well as high school music clinics. Landkreis Kassel will support the travel 9 10 costs for the musicians, as well as a documentary filmmaker who will accompany the Trio. 11 12 The 2019 budget includes funds to further the sister county relationship. Expenditures will be incurred to cover the costs of the Edgar Knecht Trio concerts and related events, including travel 13 within Dane County, outreach to high schools and tickets for students, meals, possibly lodging, 14 and costs associated with performing and recording the concerts. Opportunities to partner with 15 local groups may require costs for musicians and associated costs. 16 17 18 Donations from individuals or organizations may be solicited and received to support the expenditures described above. 19 20 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors approves 22 expenses related to the upcoming cultural exchange with Kassel, Germany. 23 24 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that revenue account COBOARD NEW "Sister County Donations be 25 established to received donations to off-set the costs of this and future initiatives related to the 26 Dane County-Landkreis Kassel partnership, and expenditure account COBOARD "Sister County 27 Donation Expense" be established and that expenditures from this account are authorized to the 28 extent donation revenues are received, and that any unexpended funds in this line be carried 29 forward to future fiscal years.
